Dental caries is most infectious disease worldwide and remains the number one reason for missed school days in children. It is my hope that this book will serve as a simple, intuitive tool to guide parents to do the following effectively: a) to instill an effective dental hygiene routine that will be upheld through adulthood, b) to improve and preserve both oral and overall health in children, and most importantly, c) invoke awareness by incorporating the same dental language pediatric dentists use in your homes.

Please read this guide first, and then incorporate age-appropriate language when teaching your children oral hygiene. There are common dental procedures outlined using age-appropriate language used by most dentists. I want to teach you this pediatric dental language as well as the dental procedures.
